RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE DELEGATION OF THE CONDUCT OF SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT TO PAO-SUPPLY SECTION FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE PEST AND TERMITE CONTROL SERVICE FOR CY 2024, AS SPECIFIED UNDER PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 815-09-2023, FOR PAO-CENTRAL OFFICE, GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION (GSD), IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANNEX "H," NO. IV, SUBSECTION (J) OF THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. (RA) 9184

WHEREAS, the Public Attorney's Office (PAO) is committed to adhere to the State's Policy of securing and maintaining the trust and confidence of every Filipino, by upholding transparency, good governance and anti-corruption measures;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Office is in urgent need of the supply for the subject items as described in detail in above stated purchase request to ensure unhampered performance of its duties and to prevent delays in its daily transactions;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned end-user unit forwarded a letter request for small value procurement to the PBAC for the subject item;

WHEREAS, there is an approved budget for the contract of the subject procurement with a total amount of Sixty Thousand Pesos (Php 60,000.00)¹;

WHEREAS, since the pursuit of a competitive bidding will result in the award of the contract only after the lapse of one hundred twenty (120) days from the start of the procurement process, said period may not be responsive to the immediate need of the Office

WHEREAS, considering that the PBAC previously issued a resolution dated 16 November 2018, delegating to the PAO-Supply Section the authority to undertake immediate procurement of goods and services in amounts less than one million pesos, in accordance with Annex "H" No. IV, Subsection (J) of the IRR of RA 9184, BAC Member Atty. Alem Abeya moved to delegate to PAO-Supply Section the conduct of procurement of the subject item, duly seconded by BAC Member Dir. Marilyn S. Boongaling;

NOW THEREFORE, WE, the Members of the PAO Bids and Awards Committee (PBAC), by virtue of the powers vested on Us by Law, after duly considering the



1. Approved Budget for the Contract

The bidder shall bid for the items described in this Terms of Reference, which shall not exceed the Approved Budget for the Contract in the amount of SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php 60,000.00), inclusive of all taxes applicable and bank and government charges payable.

A. Service Requirements

- A.1 General Pests

 Control of Flying Insects (CFI)
 Control of Rodents (CR)
- A.2 Termites
 Control of Termites (CT)

B. Objective

As a whole, the objective is to control if not eradicate the pests and termites infesting the Public Attorney's Office Central Office Building which consists the following:

4th Floor 5th Floor Penthouse

DOJ Agencies Building NIA Road Corner, East Avenue, Quezon City.

II. SCOPE OF WORKS

The Contractor's Scope of Works shall comprise but not limited to the following:

A. General Pests Extermination and Control Program with Fogging Treatment

1. Crawling Insects (CCI)

Residual Spraying supplemented by insecticidal baiting/dusting for the control of cockroaches, ants and other crawling insect pests.

Service comes in the form of spraying of specially formulated pesticides against all disease transmitting and destructive flying and crawling insects found in the buildings. The treatment should guarantee the control of the general infestation right on the spot with long residual effect.

2. Flying Insects (CFI) (including larvae

Fogging and misting operations supplemented by residual spraying for the control of mosquitoes, flies and other flying insect pests.

2.1 Fogging Method

The pesticides shall be applied to entire areas including garden areas, garbage disposal areas, canal, etc, via the method of fogging to eliminate existing infestation of flying insects particularly mosquitoes, flies, etc, including crawling insects such as cockroaches, etc. and the preemption of their reemergence due to the residual effect of the chemical used.

2.2 Misting Method

Misting method shall be performed with the use of misting equipment which transforms spray into microns for effective control of all disease transmitting and destructive crawling and flying insects.

3.Rodents(CR)

Rodents control is implemented alongside the above-mentioned program by the installation of effectively proven mechanical devices and/or non-mechanical method including the use of anti-coagulant baits.

B. Termites Extermination and Control Program

- 1. Control of Termites (CT). Soil poisoning, Wood drenching, Termite Abatement.
- 1.1 Soil Poisoning- Soil poisoning shall be done around the buildings as close as possible to the base of the outside walls using liquid termicides. It makes the soil uninhabitable from subterranean termites, controls any present infestation and discourages future subterranean infestation.
- 1.2 Wood Drenching-The infested and other wooden parts of te buildings especially the floorings, ceiling and walling shall be treated by direct spraying of liquid termicidal solution, This type of treatment shall guarantee the control of general infestation and helps minimize future further infestation. Wood protectant shall be applied with preservative quality to baseboards, door jambs and wooden ceiling, walls, partitions, etc., whenever applicable.
- 1.3 Termite Abatement and Maintenance Program (TAMP) Powder termicides shall be applied by wood injection or trophallaxis method to all places where the possible signs of infestation. The powder termicides should gradually contaminate and kill the termites in the entire colony. Regular TAMP inspection and service should minimize the possibility of infestation by dry wood termites as well as by subterranean termites

III. SPECIFICATIONS

Chemical to be used:

Only odorless with low mammalian toxicity registered with and approved by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) shall be used/applied for the adequate and effective control of each target activity by a Certified

Pesticide Applicator (Fumigator and Exterminator).

IV. EQUIPMENT, CHEMICALS AND APPLICATION

1. Furnishing all materials, equipment, transportation and supply of chemical duly registered under the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) necessary for Pest and Termite Control Treatment and Services.
