RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE PROCUREMENT OF TWO (2) INDUSTRIAL FANS SPECIFIED UNDER PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 795-07-2018 FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FORENSIC TEAM FOR DENGVAXIA-RELATED CONCERNS THROUGH SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT (SVP) UNDER SECTION 53.9 IN RELATION TO ANNEX "H," NO. V, SUBSECTION (D)8-a OF THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. (RA) 9184

WHEREAS, the Public Attorney's Office (PAO) is committed to adhere to its mandate to represent, free of charge, indigents, and other persons qualified for legal assistance in all civil, criminal, labor, administrative and other quasi-judicial cases where, after due evaluation, it is determined that the interest of justice will be served thereby¹;

WHEREAS, in view of the Department Order No. 792 of the Secretary of Justice addressed to the Public Attorney's Office, to render the necessary assistance to any and all Dengvaxia-related concerns², the PAO Forensics Team exhumed and performed autopsies on alleged victims wherein use of industrial fans are deemed necessary in the performance of said actions;

WHEREAS, the PAO-Administrative Service submitted to the PBAC a request for small value procurement Office in compliance with the IRR of RA 9184 of two (2) units of industrial fans for the use of the PAO Forensics Team;

WHEREAS, considering that subject industrial fans are not listed among the items available in the DBM-PS, and the current need of the PAO-Forensic Team for the item is necessary for the convenient discharge of its tasks;

WHEREAS, considering that the pursuit of a competitive bidding relative to the procurement of the same shall likely be concluded only after the lapse of one hundred twenty (120) days, which period, may no longer be responsive to the immediate need of the Office;

WHEREAS, ultimately considering that the purchase of the mentioned items contemplates a purchase of things NOT considered as "ordinary or regular office


supplies," not available in the DBM-PS, and hence not an item susceptible for shopping, the practicality and necessity in procuring the same in accordance with ANNEX "H," NO. V, SUBSECTION (D)8-a, of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184 is thus in order.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, the Members of the PAO Bids and Awards Committee (PBAC), by virtue of the powers vested on Us by Law, after duly considering the recommendations of the Technical Working Group (TWG), and all members here present, including The Secretariat, **hereby resolve to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity the pursuance of a SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT (SVP) UNDER SECTION 53.9 IN RELATION TO ANNEX "H," NO. V, SUBSECTION (D)8-a OF THE REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. (RA) 9184, in purchasing the two (2) INDUSTRIAL FANS as described in PURCHASE REQUEST NO. 795-07-2018, for the use of the PAO Forensics Team.**




