**ABANDON THE NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT OF SERVICE VEHICLES FOR FOR THE PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR 2019 AND RESORT TO PROCUREMENT THROUGH DBM-PS**

**WHEREAS**, the Public Attorney's Office (PAO) is committed to adhere to the State's Policy of securing and maintaining the trust and confidence of every Filipino, by upholding transparency, good governance and anti-corruption measures;

**WHEREAS**, The PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S OFFICE BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (PBAC) in its resolution dated 27 November 2019, previously resolved to undertake negotiated procurement after two-failed biddings for the procurement of PAO-Central Office Service Vehicles for CY 2019, in accordance with Section 53.1 of the IRR of R.A. No. 9184;

**WHEREAS**, PBAC posted and advertised its decision to conduct negotiated procurement in the PAO website, PAO-Central Office lobby and in the PhilGEPS under Reference No. 6704506;

**WHEREAS**, quotations and offers were received from Toyota-Abad Santos, Manila; Toyota-Valenzuela City; Toyota-Otis and Toyota-Marilao, Bulacan, Inc., but examination of all the received quotations, except for the quotation from Toyota-Abad Santos, exceeded the approved budget of the contact and is thus rejected;

**WHEREAS**, while the price quotation of Toyota-Abad Santos is within the approved budget for the contract, its Philgeps registration is not updated and the specifications in its offer is not responsive to the required specifications of the subject procurement, resulting to the rejection of the said quotation;

**WHEREAS**, after the evaluation of the PBAC with the assistance of the Technical Working Group and considering the time constraints in the procurement of the subject service vehicles, BAC Member Atty. Marilyn Balbin moved to abandon the subject negotiated procurement and to procurement the subject service vehicles through DBM-PS instead, duly seconded by BAC Member Atty. Flordeliza Merelos;
